Local Ministry Partners Receiving Distributions

At the end of the calendar year, Council set an amount of \$3000 for distribution to local ministry partners. The Serving Ministry Board then met to determine agencies and allocations for these funds. This year's allocations were as follows: Trinity Episcopal Church — \$1000 for upkeep of their kitchen used for PADS; 360 Youth Services of Naperville — \$1000 for LGBTQ youth transitional housing; Lutheran Suicide Prevention Ministry — \$1000 for their work to educate churches and individuals about suicide prevention and to work with survivors of suicide. Please look for more information on these important agencies each of the next three Sundays during worship.
