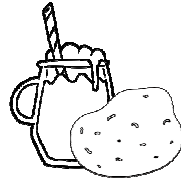


# Announcements for February 10, 2019—Scout Sunday

A new session of Spiritual Yoga begins February 18.

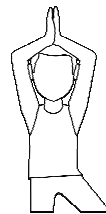
Classes are Monday nights from 7-8 pm in the chapel.

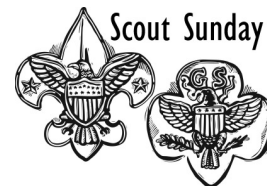
