## Caring Board

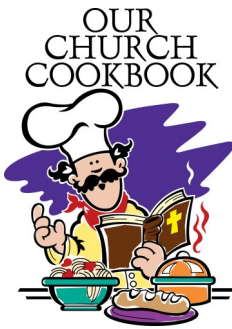

## 2018 Health Insurance Coverage

The DuPage Health Department has a helpful website, [www.getdupagecovered.org](http://www.getdupagecovered.org), to help residents of DuPage County access health coverage.

- If you are a current participant in an ACA healthcare plan, you may not receive notice of **Open Enrollment, which is from November 1 through December 15** for 2018 coverage.
- DuPage County has 3 carriers and if you enroll you will have coverage through 2018. Congress cannot retroactively take away your coverage.
- 80% qualify for a discount of some sort.
