Volunteer Needed

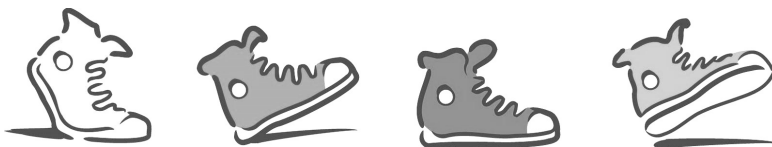

First download the app – you will be asked to enter your email address as it's listed in our directory. If your email address isn't listed in the directory, let Julie in the office know so it can be added. Once you enter your email address, follow the directions on screen to complete the login process. After you login, the directory will be downloaded to your device. Anytime updates are made, they will update on your device too. In the app you will be able to search for members and call, email, and text from your device.
