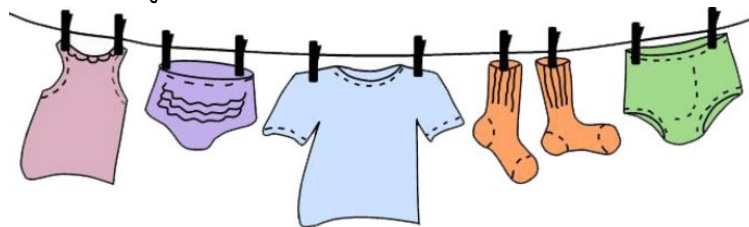
2019 Women's Retreat: Share in the Joyful Noise
